**David Claeys** is president of Beaumont Hospital, Dearborn, part of Beaumont Health, Michigan's largest health care system, based on inpatient admissions and net patient revenue. He is responsible for strategy development, daily operations and financial performance of this 632-bed acute care, teaching and research hospital.

Claeys assumed a role as Beaumont, Dearborn's interim president in April 2017 before being appointed as the permanent president in October 2017. Prior to this, he served as Beaumont Hospital, Troy's chief operating officer with administrative responsibility for the operations of the 520-bed tertiary hospital and its five ambulatory medical centers. During his tenure at Beaumont, Troy, he also served as vice president, Heart & Vascular and Surgical Services; administrative director, Ancillary Services; and director, Radiologic Services.

After serving in the U.S. Navy, Claeys began his health care career as a patient transporter, later serving as a respiratory therapist and on the cardiothoracic surgical staff at various hospitals in Metro Detroit. He graduated from the University of Detroit-Mercy Physician Assistant Program and joined Beaumont, Troy in 2005 as a physician assistant.

He is a fellow of the American College of Health Care Executives and has served as a board member of the Macomb County Chamber of Commerce, Macomb Foundation and Macomb Advocacy for Growth.

In addition to his master's degree in physician assistant studies, Claeys earned a bachelor's in Health Care Administration from the University of Detroit-Mercy.

Beaumont Health is a not-for-profit organization formed in 2014 by Beaumont Health System, Botsford Hospital and Oakwood Healthcare to provide patients and families with compassionate, extraordinary care, no matter where they live in Southeast Michigan. It consists of eight hospitals with 3,429 beds, 187 outpatient sites, nearly 5,000 physicians, more than 38,000 employees and 3,500 volunteers.
