**Constance O'Malley, RN** is president of Beaumont Hospital, Farmington Hills at Beaumont Health, Michigan's largest health care system, based on inpatient admissions and net patient revenue.

In this role, O'Malley is responsible for strategy development, daily operations and financial performance of the 330-bed full-service teaching hospital, as well as development of ambulatory sites that are part of Beaumont, Farmington Hills. Previously, she served as vice president and chief operating officer of Beaumont Hospital, Troy for four years, where she was responsible for daily operations and ambulatory services. Prior to this, she served as vice president of Surgical Services, Trauma, Transplant and Ambulatory Services at Beaumont Hospital, Royal Oak with administrative responsibility for Beaumont Medical Center, West Bloomfield.

Before joining Beaumont, O'Malley held a variety of leadership positions with Ascension Health - St. John Providence Health System and Detroit Medical Center, including vice president of Clinical Services, chief nursing officer and chief operating officer. She has more than 30 years of health care experience and began her career as a surgical nurse at Providence Hospital.

She has been a fellow of the American College of Health Care Executives since 2012 and serves on many nonprofit boards, leading both the Oakland and Macomb County Medical Control Authorities as President.

O'Malley earned her Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Oakland University and her master's degree in health service administration from Madonna University.

Beaumont Health is a not-for-profit organization formed in 2014 by Beaumont Health System, Botsford Hospital and Oakwood Healthcare to provide patients and families with compassionate, extraordinary care, no matter where they live in Southeast Michigan. It consists of eight hospitals with 3,429 beds, 174 outpatient sites, nearly 5,000 physicians, 38,000 employees and 3,500 volunteers. In 2016, the organization had \$4.4 billion in net revenue with nearly 178,000 inpatient discharges, 568,000 emergency visits and more than 17,500 births.
