Constance O'Malley, RN is president, Outpatient Services for Beaumont Health, Michigan's largest health care system, based on inpatient admissions and net patient revenue. In this role, she is responsible for outpatient activity as well as current and future Beaumont ambulatory surgery centers and campuses. The role also encompasses urgent care sites, imaging and radiology, telehealth and e-visits, Beaumont Mobile Medicine EMS services and the Access Center.

Prior to this, O'Malley served as president of Beaumont Hospital, Farmington Hills, where she was responsible for strategy development, daily operations and financial performance of the 330-bed full-service teaching hospital as well as development for ambulatory sites. She led the hospital's \$160 million expansion project, including private patient care and critical care towers, and emergency and operating room expansion and renovation. Previously, she served as vice president and chief operating officer of Beaumont Hospital, Troy. She has also served as vice president of Surgical Services, Trauma, Transplant and Ambulatory Services at Beaumont Hospital, Royal Oak.

Prior to Beaumont, O'Malley held a variety of leadership positions with Ascension Health - St. John Providence Health System and Detroit Medical Center, including vice president of Clinical Services, Chief Nursing Officer and Chief Operating Officer. She has been a fellow of the American College of Health Care Executives since 2012 and serves on many nonprofit boards, including the Southfield and West Bloomfield Chambers of Commerce. She received the Oakland University Odyssey Award in 2018.

O'Malley earned her Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Oakland University and her master's degree in health service administration from Madonna University.

Beaumont Health is Michigan's largest health care system and is most preferred for health care in Southeast Michigan, according to NRC Health survey data. The not-for-profit organization was created to provide patients with greater access to compassionate, extraordinary care every day. Beaumont has a total net revenue of \$4.7 billion and consists of eight hospitals with 3,429 beds, 145 outpatient sites, nearly 5,000 physicians, 38,000 employees and 3,500 volunteers.
