Laura A. Glenn is senior vice president and executive director of Beaumont Health Physician Partners, part of Beaumont Health, Michigan's largest health care system, based on inpatient admissions and net patient revenue.

In this role, Glenn works to optimize and integrate physician services, including physician contracting, credentialing and working with physician organizations, with a focus on providing a high quality physician network. Glenn also leads efforts to integrate the employed physicians of Beaumont Health through the Beaumont Medical Group.

Prior to this position, Glenn served as vice president and chief operating officer for Beaumont Physician Partners with operational and budgetary responsibility for all Beaumont Medical Group clinical departments and functions of the Oakland University William Beaumont School of Medicine related to Beaumont Health System. Glenn joined Beaumont in 2008 as director of surgical services program development.

Glenn is a Crain's "40 Under 40" honoree and a recipient of the Oakland County Executive's Elite 40 under 40. She is a former member of the University of Michigan Health Management & Policy Group, the Southeast Michigan Center for Medical Education Board of Directors and the American College of Healthcare Executives.

Glenn earned her master's degree in health services administration from the University of Michigan School of Public Health and her bachelor's degree in health fitness in preventive and rehabilitative programs from Central Michigan University.
