James P. Lynch, M.D., M.B.A., is senior vice president and chief medical officer for Beaumont Hospital, Troy, part of Beaumont Health, Michigan's largest health care system, based on inpatient admissions and net patient revenue.

Dr. Lynch was appointed chief medical officer at Beaumont, Troy in 2010. In this role, he closely collaborates with medical and hospital leadership, including the Medical Executive Committee, hospital president and elected chief of staff. Dr. Lynch is responsible for overall hospital performance and developing the vision and strategic plan for clinical activities. Dr. Lynch also serves as chief of Colon and Rectal Surgery at Troy.

Dr. Lynch has been a member of the medical staffs at Beaumont, Troy and Beaumont, Royal Oak since 1988.

He is certified by the American Board of Colon and Rectal Surgery and is a fellow of the American Society of Colon and Rectal Surgeons. He is also a member of the Michigan Surgical Quality Collaborative and the National Surgical Quality Improvement Project, as well as a past president of the Michigan Society of Colon and Rectal Surgeons. He was named a "Top Doc" by *Hour Detroit* Magazine in 2010.

Dr. Lynch received his medical degree from Wayne State University and performed his post-doctoral surgical training at Beaumont Hospital. He also has a master's degree in Business Administration from Oakland University, and is an assistant professor at the Oakland University William Beaumont School of Medicine.
