Jonathan Maner is senior vice president and executive director of Beaumont Health Physician Partners. Beaumont Health is Michigan's largest health care system, based on inpatient admissions and net patient revenue.

Jonathan's responsibilities include optimizing and integrating Beaumont Health physician services, including physician contracting, credentialing and working with physician organizations.

Maner has nearly 20 years of experience with health care organizations across the country, including Northwest Health System in Arkansas, Navarro Regional Hospital in Texas.

He came to Beaumont from the Trinity Health System Office Physician Network Organization, where he served as vice president of operational excellence since 2015. At Trinity, he led the operational and financial transformation of the physician organization, which spans 22 states and includes about 1,700 practices with 7,000 physicians.

Prior to that, he served as the senior vice president of physician services for the Trinity Health - St. Mary Physician Group.

Maner served in the United States Army for nearly 10 years in both the 101st Airborne Division and the 10th Mountain Division. He received his degree in business administration from Capella University in Minneapolis, Minn.

Beaumont Health is a not-for-profit organization formed in 2014 by Beaumont Health System, Botsford Hospital and Oakwood Healthcare to provide patients and families with compassionate, extraordinary care, no matter where they live in Southeast Michigan. It consists of eight hospitals with 3,429 beds, 187 outpatient sites, nearly 5,000 physicians, more than 38,000 employees and 3,500 volunteers.
