**Subra Sripada** is executive vice president and chief information officer at Beaumont Health, Michigan's largest health care system, based on inpatient admissions and net patient revenue.

Sripada came to Beaumont Health from Beaumont Health System, where he served as executive vice president, chief administrative officer and chief information officer. He joined Beaumont in 2008.

Prior to joining Beaumont Health System, Sripada served in a leadership role at PricewaterhouseCoopers, a global management consulting firm, where he consulted on health information technology and business strategy in the U.S. and internationally. He has also held leadership positions at CapGemini Ernst & Young, Ernst & Young and Henry Ford Health System.

Sripada is a member of the College of Health Information Management Executives and serves on several customer health care boards. He has also served on the board of the health information exchange consortium Michigan Health Connect, the Governor's Cyber Security Council, the State CIO Cabinet and the American Heart Association's Metro Detroit board of directors. He was named a "Hospital and Health System CIO to Know" by Becker's Hospital Review in 2017 and 2018.

Sripada earned his Bachelor of Science in mechanical engineering from Osmania University in India and his master's in industrial and systems engineering from Kansas State University.

Beaumont Health is Michigan's largest health care system and is most preferred for health care in Southeast Michigan, according to NRC Health survey data. The not-for-profit organization was created to provide patients with greater access to compassionate, extraordinary care every day. Beaumont has a total net revenue of \$4.7 billion and consists of eight hospitals with 3,429 beds, 145 outpatient sites, nearly 5,000 physicians, 38,000 employees and 3,500 volunteers.
