Subra Sripada is executive vice president, chief transformation officer and chief information officer at Beaumont Health, Michigan's largest health care system, based on inpatient admissions and net patient revenue.

Sripada came to Beaumont Health from Beaumont Health System, where he served as executive vice president, chief administrative officer and chief information officer. He joined Beaumont in 2008 as associate chief information officer, later advancing to vice president and chief information officer and then senior vice president and chief information officer.

Prior to joining Beaumont Health System, Sripada served in a leadership role at PricewaterhouseCoopers, a global management consulting firm, where he consulted on health information technology and business strategy in the U.S. and internationally. He has also held leadership positions at CapGemini Ernst & Young, Ernst & Young and Henry Ford Health System.

Sripada is a member of the College of Health Information Management Executives. He serves on the health care advisory boards of Microsoft, SAP and AT&T. He has also served on the board of the health information exchange consortium Michigan Health Connect, the Governor's Cyber Security Council, the State CIO Cabinet and the American Heart Association's Metro Detroit board of directors. He was named a "Hospital and Health System CIO to Know" by Becker's Hospital Review in 2017.

Sripada earned his Bachelor of Science in mechanical engineering from Osmania University in India and his master's in industrial and systems engineering from Kansas State University.

Beaumont Health is a not-for-profit organization formed in 2014 by Beaumont Health System, Botsford Hospital and Oakwood Healthcare to provide patients and families with compassionate, extraordinary care, no matter where they live in Southeast Michigan.
