Rick Swaine is president of Beaumont Hospital, Grosse Pointe at Beaumont Health, Michigan's largest health care system, based on inpatient admissions and net patient revenue.

In this role, Swaine is responsible for the financial performance and operations of the 280-bed hospital. Previously, he served as vice president of Finance for Beaumont's hospitals in Royal Oak and Troy. Swaine joined Beaumont in 1985 as an assistant controller. He began his career as an audit manager for Hungerford Cooper Luxon and Company.

Swaine serves on the Board of Directors and Executive Committee, Greater Detroit Area Health Council; the Board of Directors and Finance Committee for Detroit Cass Community; and the Board of Beaumont Medical Transportation.

Swaine earned his Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting from Lawrence Institute of Technology. He became a Certified Public Accountant in 1983 and earned his Master of Science in Finance from Walsh College.

Beaumont Health is a not-for-profit organization formed in 2014 by Beaumont Health System, Botsford Hospital and Oakwood Healthcare to provide patients and families with compassionate, extraordinary care, no matter where they live in Southeast Michigan. It consists of eight hospitals with 3,429 beds, 187 outpatient sites, nearly 5,000 physicians, more than 38,000 employees and 3,500 volunteers.
