Timothy C. Dr. Lyons joined Beaumont from Adventist Health St. Helena in northern California, where he served as chief medical officer since 2017. Prior to this role, he was chief of staff at St. Helena and served as medical director of Anesthesia since 2002.

Dr. Lyons has 28 years of progressive experience building and retaining teams and leading operations. He has successfully designed, implemented and grown several service lines and led St. Helena to Medicare 5 Star and Leapfrog A ratings. Dr. Lyons is the president and founder of Lyons Huber Anesthesia and Lyons Huber Management and was an assistant professor of anesthesiology at University Hospitals of Cleveland for seven years.

Dr. Lyons earned a Bachelor of Science from Youngstown State University, a medical degree from Northeast Ohio Medical University and a master's degree in Healthcare Management from Harvard University. In 2022, Dr. Lyons received the prestigious Fellow of the American Society of Anesthesiologists designation for his dedication and leadership in the field of anesthesiology.
