Kendall Troyer currently serves as senior vice president for Corewell Health Medical Group East, the new name for Beaumont Medical Group. In this role, Kendall works alongside the medical group president to set strategic direction and priorities for more than 1,000 employed physicians at Corewell Health East.

Kendall is working with independent and employed physicians to improve access, launch a new Services Line structure and grow the physician network. He is focused on contracting, including preparing the medical group for value-based contracts.

Kendall previously served in dual roles at Spectrum Health Lakeland as vice president of the medical group for two years along with vice president of Quality, chief quality officer for six years. He implemented a Physician Compensation Oversight Committee to govern the contracting process and enhance physician involvement, led the development of a master plan to modernize physician practice facilities and implemented a new leadership structure designed to enhance physician leadership within the medical group. As chief quality officer, his responsibilities spanned physician practice, hospital and post-acute care. His 28 years of leadership experience includes hospital administration, revenue cycle leadership and implementation of an enterprisewide electronic health record.

Kendall holds a Bachelor of Science in clinical laboratory science from Michigan State University, a Master of Health Services Administration from University of Michigan, and Doctor of Public Health from Johns Hopkins University, Bloomberg School of Public Health.
