Eric W. Widner, FACHE is president of Beaumont Hospital, Wayne, which is part of Beaumont Health, Michigan's largest health care system, based on inpatient admissions and net patient revenue.

In this role, Widner is responsible for strategy development, daily operations and financial performance of the 185-bed teaching hospital. He previously served as chief operating officer of Beaumont Hospital, Taylor, and as administrator for orthopedics and neurosciences for Oakwood Healthcare system.

Widner joined Oakwood in 2005 with 18 years of experience in senior leadership roles in medical imaging services, medical and dental group practice management, and hospital administration in Florida, Massachusetts and Ohio. He serves on the Board of Directors of Health Emergency Medical Services Inc., Starfish Family Services and the Midwest Chapter of the American College of Healthcare Executives. He is an American College of Healthcare Executives Fellow, a graduate of Leadership Detroit Class XXXI, and a member of Rotary International of Wayne, Michigan.

Widner earned his master's degree in Healthcare Services Administration from Nova Southeastern University in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, and his bachelor's degree in Medical Record Administration from Bowling Green State University in Ohio.
