Sadler joined Beaumont in 2023 to oversee the nursing program for the 9,000+ nurses across Beaumont. She came from Novant Health in North Carolina, where she served as the vice president and chief nursing officer for the health system's Charlotte area, which included multiple hospitals and medical centers. Under her leadership, Novant Health earned three Magnet designations and several improvements were made to the nursing program. This resulted in positive patient outcomes, such as reducing hospital acquired infections.

Sadler has served in numerous roles throughout her 28-year career, such as bedside nurse, Nursing supervisor, assistant nurse manager, corporate manager for Risk Management and Nursing director.

She earned her associate degree in nursing from Gaston College, bachelor's in nursing from Winston-Salem State University and her master's in health administration from Pfeiffer University.

Sadler is a 2015 graduate of Leadership Development Initiative sponsored by Community Builders Initiative, a 2017 graduate of the Novant Health Leadership Academy and a 2018 graduate of L.I.F.T.-Leveraging Internal Female Talent.
