- robotic and minimally invasive surgical therapy

  - breast cancer/BRCA 1 and 2 germline mutations
  - ovarian cancer
  - endometrial/Lynch syndrome

**Barry Rosen, M.D.**, is the section head of Beaumont's gynecologic oncology program. Originally from Canada, Dr. Rosen was the head of gynecologic oncology at the University of Toronto for 13 years. He provides comprehensive care and treatment for women with ovarian, uterine, cervical and vulvar cancers, as well as those

diagnosed with gestational trophoblastic diseases. His scope of practice also includes prevention; in Toronto he led a program in hereditary cancer that was focused on identifying those with BRCA germline mutations and then providing cancer prevention strategies to gene mutation carriers.



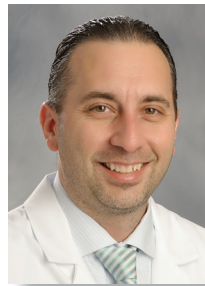

surgery. He also specializes in treating women with a hereditary predisposition to ovarian and breast cancer/BRCA germline mutations and prevention of ovarian cancer.

Clinically, Dr. Field is interested in uterine cancer, cervical cancer, minimally invasive surgery and fertility sparing surgery. He is actively involved in collecting tissue for

Dr. Field received his bachelor's degree in microbiology from the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor. He is a graduate of Wayne State University School of Medicine in Detroit and completed his residency at Hutzel Hospital, Wayne State University in Detroit. He then went on to complete his fellowship in gynecologic oncology at the University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston.



**J. Anthony Rakowski, D.O.**, is the head of gynecologic oncology at the Beaumont hospitals in Dearborn and Farmington Hills. He is board certified in gynecologic oncology and OB-GYN by the American Osteopathic Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology. Dr. Rakowski provides comprehensive surgical
