- ambulatory patient services (outpatient care you get without being admitted to a hospital)
- emergency services
- hospitalization (such as surgery)
- maternity and newborn care (care before and after your baby is born)
- mental health and substance use disorder services, including behavioral health treatment (this includes counseling and psychotherapy)
- prescription drugs
- rehabilitative services and devices (to help people with injuries, disabilities or chronic conditions, gain or recover mental and physical skills)
- laboratory services
- preventive and wellness services and chronic disease management
- pediatric services

## Documents needed to enroll

Be sure to bring these items to your appointment or an enrollment fair:

- picture identification
- Social Security numbers (or document numbers for legal immigrants) of everyone in household that needs coverage
- employer and income information for every member of your household who needs insurance coverage (for example, pay stubs or W-2 wage and tax statements)
- policy numbers for any current health insurance plans covering members of your household
