

Beaumont Hospital, Farmington Hills

Facts and Figures



Beaumont Hospital, Farmington Hills (formerly Botsford Hospital) opened on Jan. 19, 1965 as a 200-bed community hospital. Today, the hospital is a 330-bed facility with Level II trauma status. It is a major osteopathic teaching facility with 18 accredited residency and fellowship programs. Beaumont, Farmington Hills is the base teaching hospital for Michigan State University College of Osteopathic Medicine. Botsford became part of Beaumont Health in September 2014.

Specialty Services

Cancer Center: radiation oncology using a multi-functional linear accelerator with intensity modulated radiation therapy and image-guided radiation therapy; medical oncology practices providing 19 infusion bays; equipped with CT scan for patient simulation and treatment planning; diagnostic PET CT; advanced high-dose rate brachytherapy for prostate and breast cancer; Mohs surgery; and surgical removal of keloid and treatment of site with direct electron beam irradiation.

Da Vinci Surgery: robotic and computer-assisted platform for minimally invasive surgeries, including hysterectomy, myomectomy (removing uterine fibroids), ovarian/fallopian tube problems, gynecologic oncology, sacrocolpopexy (pelvic organ prolapse), endometriosis, prostate surgery, full and partial nephrectomy (kidney removal), bowel surgery, gallbladder surgery, general surgery, sleep apnea/ear/nose/throat surgery, and more.

Emergency and Trauma Center: western Oakland County's first verified Level-II Trauma Center; all board-certified emergency medicine physicians; dedicated technology, including X-ray, CT, ultrasound, MRI and other advanced equipment; certified as a Stroke Center of Excellence.

Orthopedics: total/partial joint replacement of hip, knee, shoulder; minimally invasive procedures to reduce pain and speed recovery; arthroscopic and reconstructive surgery of knee, shoulder, elbow and wrist; hand surgery; ACL reconstruction; rotator cuff surgery; complete spinal care; pain management techniques; non-operative orthopedic care; physical therapy; certified hand therapy.

Cardiology Services: EKG, stress testing, cardiac CT, cardiac catheterization center renovated in 2016, pacemaker implantation, internal defibrillator implantation, EECOP therapy, full-service cardiac rehabilitation, elective and emergency angioplasty.

Lab Services: same advanced robotic and computerized systems found in major universities and the full range of testing services, including anatomic and clinical pathology.

Imaging Center: 128-slice CT scanner, open-bore magnetic resonance imaging, combined PET (Positron Emission Tomography)-CT scans, digital mammography with tomography, breast MRI, a variety of diagnostic X-rays, stereotactic breast biopsy, ultrasound and nuclear medicine studies.

Endoscopy Services: EBUS, a minimally invasive method for diagnosing lung diseases; Bravo Capsule; bronchoscopy; colonoscopy; gastroscopy; endoscopic retrograde cholangiopancreatography; liver biopsy; extracorporeal shockwave lithotripsy; paracentesis; small bowel endoscopy; thoracentesis; and esophageal manometry/24-hour pH testing.
