## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE ELIGIBILITY POLICY SUMMARY

Thank you for choosing us for your healthcare needs. Our goal is to provide all patients with high quality health care services regardless of their financial circumstances. We offer financial assistance to patients for emergency and other medically necessary care in accordance with our Financial Assistance Policy (Policy).

### Who is Eligible?

We offer financial assistance to patients who meet the requirements of our Policy. Eligibility is based on multiple factors, including insurance coverage and other sources of payment (such as for personal injury claims), income, family size and assets. The Policy provides free care for those who have tried all other payment options, and:

- Have household income at or below 250% of the current year's Federal Poverty Guidelines;
- Have submitted a properly completed application.

If you qualify for financial assistance, you will not be charged more than amounts generally billed for emergency or medically necessary care.

Catastrophic financial assistance may also be available if you have suffered a significant medical and financial event.
