- Must hold a bachelor's degree accredited in the U.S.
- Program length: January – August
- 34-weeks, full time internship, Monday - Friday
- Eligible to sit for Registered Dietitian (RD) Exam
- Dietetic Internship Program Accredited in 2013

Medical Nutrition Therapy (MNT) Focused

- Clinical – 16 weeks
- Long term care – 3 weeks
- Community nutrition – 3 weeks
- Food service management – 4 weeks
- Specialty – 3 weeks
- Didactic training – 1 week
- Orientation – 1 week
- Staff relief – 2 weeks
- Vacation – 1 week

APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS:

- Grade Point Average: minimum 3.2
- Prior work experience (paid or volunteer)
- Personal statement
- Three letters of recommendation:
 - Professor/dietetic program or dietetics director
 - Two other professional
- Extracurricular activities

SELECTION OF INTERNS:

- 8 dietetic interns per calendar year
- Fall match only
- Selection criteria – see rubric attached
- Video-chat interviews

TUITION AND COSTS:

- **Non-refundable** application fee: \$75.00
- Tuition: \$5,000.00
- Intern covers all additional expenses
- Intern provides own transportation
