To apply for a **medical graduate** Observership, you must meet the following criteria:

1. Applied through ERAS (Electronic Residency Application Service)
2. Meet the Residency program's criteria (visit Oakwood.org/meded)
3. Granted an interview for the current academic year.

REMINDERS:

- We do not accept applications earlier than **90 days** in advance and no later than **30 days** prior to the requested Observership.
- Applications will **not** be processed without all required documentation attached. Incomplete applications are not returned.
- We **do not** sponsor any Visa's – you must be a permanent resident/U.S. citizen or hold a green card.
- Observership applications are not processed within a guaranteed amount of time. First consideration is given to all present workloads.
- Applications are taken on a first come, first serve basis.
- All applications must be signed by the supervising Physician before submitting to Medical Education.
- Medical Education does not write letters of recommendation for Observerships.
- Medical Education does not complete or attest to any documents required for immigration.
- Observerships with Physicians in private practice cannot be longer than 30 days.
- **OBSERVERSHIPS ARE NOT GUARANTEED AND CAN BE TERMINATED AT ANY TIME**
