OB/GYN Call	in addition to home service rotations, residents also take OB/GYN call while assigned to Fetal Imaging, Newborn Medicine, Ambulatory Medicine and Genetics as PGY-1
OB/GYN Continuity Care Clinics	importantly, all PGY-2,3,4 residents devote a half-day per week protected time in the OB/GYN outpatient clinics; each resident has a patient panel inclusive of obstetric, gynecologic, primary and preventive care, and annual health maintenance patient care under direct faculty supervision
